## Welcome!

We are so glad that you have joined us for this evening's event, which we hope sparks new conversations about Cape Verdean independence, musical culture, and the meaning of liberation.

These events started off as a series of conversations between us in the fall of 2022, as we each began to think about ways to begin to rebuild the community-university relationship fractured by Brown's complicity in the gentrification and highway fragmentation of the historically Cape Verdean Fox Point neighborhood. Together, we came up with the idea for an event series that features the music, activism, and scholarship of Cape Verdeans in New England, to highlight Criolu (and Criola!) voices. This series is a true collaboration between Brown University and the Capeverdean American Community Development Center, and is intended to bring together the Cape Verdean community and the Brown community in dialogue and in hands-on learning. We do not imagine that this work is anywhere near done, but we hope to offer an opening, and a beginning, for the reparative work of the future.

After nearly a year of ideation, we were lucky enough to receive institutional support for this dream in the form of a grant from the Brown Arts Institute, who is helping us to produce these events as part of their inaugural IGNITE! series. We thank everyone at the BAI for their support; the board and all staff at the CACD; as well as the Brown University Music Department DIAP Committee for their support.
